>>>> HELP ALONG THE WAY

I had been skiing all day with friends and family. It was a cold December night in North Carolina. It was about 8:30. I was tired, but wanted one more run down that hill. Kristie had asked me to not go, the hot chocolate was ready. "One more", I said, "then I'm done." No truer words were spoken that evening.

Night skiing can be fun, but dangerous. There were shadows everywhere and the temperature was falling, meaning that some of the snow that had melted during the day was turning to ice. I sensed danger and prayed, "Lord, please help me get down this hill." As I started down, I gained speed and felt in control - at least at first. About one-third of the way down, the edge of my left ski caught ice and spun like a helicopter blade. My left leg snapped like a twig. I instantly knew it was broken. I lay there in a heap. Minutes later, I was coming down the mountain - on the back of a medic's sled.

Seven months later, after surgery and a long recovery, I completed a 10K run - an accomplishment that I did not achieve alone. I had lots of help. From the instant of my injury to running that 10k, I was blessed to have folks assisting me along the way. I look back at the whole event and see all kinds of lessons. I had no business being at the top of that hill. God did answer my prayer, only maybe I should have been more specific. Or perhaps, if I hadn't crashed when I did, I could have a bit further down where the injuries could have been more severe - or worse, hurt someone else.

One key lesson is to never underestimate God's ability to take a negative and turn it into a positive. The old self, becomes something new. New to us, but not new to God. If you are having trouble seeing God's work in the dark times of life - or know someone who is - ask one of the Pastors about Stephen Ministry. Your inquiry, like everything else we do, is confidential. We will walk with you as you find the path that God has set before you. You have help along the way.
