The Hope Lodge provides a caring supportive environment and lodging for a cancer patient and their caregiver. It is available for those undergoing active cancer treatment who live 40 miles or more from Birmingham. They provide 33 hotel style rooms, which are set up with cancer patients in mind. They have a laundry, library, outdoor area, and a common kitchen and dining area.
