This past Sunday was the one-year anniversary of our vote to disaffiliate from the United Methodist Church. In the coming weeks, we will celebrate the Sunday we voted to become a Global Methodist Congregation.

We have been very busy this past year, changing signs, logos, and getting new hymnals. It has been an exciting time of growth, healing and development for our congregation. In 2023, we held our first provisional annual conference in August and became The North Alabama Provisional Annual conference.

We will meet again in 2024, prior to the first General Conference of the Global Methodist Church. The Global Gathering will be in San Jose, Costa Rica on September 20-26, 2024. The reason for Costa Rica is to show that we really are a Global Denomination. (Continued on page 2)

AAII the Naomi Cirls are very thankful for everyone who has supported our local Joe Lee Griffin Hope Lodge here in Birmingham. Your support touches lives in a meaningful way at a difficult time. To date, the Naomi Girls' service project has resulted in a total of \$765 in donations given directly to the Birmingham Hope Lodge.

In case you are not familiar with it, the Joe Lee Griffin Hope Lodge here in Birmingham provides a caring and supportive lodging place for those who are undergoing cancer treatment from out of town-40 miles or more away. They provide lodging for the patient and one caregiver at no charge.

Some of the amenities include a kitchen, library, and an outdoor screened area. Each room is assigned a space in the kitchen for food so that their caregiver can prepare meals there according to their needs. Transportation to different hospitals can also be arranged if needed. This is a wonderful blessing in our community that many people are unaware of. If you have not yet gone online and looked at all the wonderful things our Hope Lodge does, please take a minute to look. You can type in Joe Lee Griffin Hope Lodge or Birmingham Hope Lodge and it will take you to it.

In addition, churches and groups are invited to contact the lodge about cooking a meal or providing crafts or games for the guests. If your group is interested in doing this, please get in touch with Candy at the church office. She will provide you with a contact at the Lodge to find out more information about it.
